

PETITION (Human Trafficking)

TO THE HONOURABLE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED

WE THE UNDERSIGNED CITIZENS OF CANADA, draw attention to the House to the following:

WHEREAS the trafficking of women and children for the purposes of sexual exploitation should be condemned;

AND WHEREAS it is the duty of Parliament to protect the most vulnerable members of society from harm, those being the victims of Human Trafficking,

THEREFORE your petitioners request that Parliament amend the Criminal Code to include a minimum punishment of imprisonment for a term of five years for offences involving trafficking of persons under the age of eighteen years.
